The Stillwater Public Library Gallery will host a sampling of Tim Nyberg's bird painting through April 2017. The exhibition will feature both Tim's trademark whimsical creations and more serious bird paintings incorporated into abstracts and Seuss-like vegetation. The paintings span over 15 years of Nyberg's transition from commercial artist to fine (he prefers "fun") artist.

A visitor to Tim's gallery once asked him why he paints so many birds? He responded, "My dad painted a lot of birds. That may have inspired me to try my own artist's hand at the creatures - a challenge to see if they'd work in conjunction with my non-objective style that has been developing. Or, it could be my love of watching birds flit about in our yard, playing in the trees, the bushes, and cautiously discovering our pond for bathing and drinks. Or, as a designer, it could be that I just appreciate the shape of a bird. Or, a combination of all of these. Whatever the reason, the little winged creatures have played a major role in my art recently."

Tim will be on hand to talk about his art and answer questions at a public reception Wednesday, March 30 beginning at 6:00 pm. Refreshments will be served and free packs of bird seed will be available compliments of Stillwater Farm Store.
